

Getting Started with Mail@umd

Mail@umd is the new e-mail service offered at the University. Students, faculty and staff affiliated with the University may have these accounts. If you are new to the University, visit <https://www.oit.umd.edu/new/student.html> to activate your account. To move your existing University e-mail account (WAM, Glue, Deans, Umail or Accmail) to Mail@umd, visit: <https://www.oit.umd.edu/email/activation.html>.

To log in to your Mail@umd account, you must use your Directory ID and password.

Accounts at the University of Maryland

Accounts

You have the following account(s):

Account	Account Name	Description
<input type="checkbox"/> Directory ID and Mail@UMD		Your Directory ID is used to log in to many systems, including: Testudo, WebCT, and your Mail@UMD e-mail account.
<input type="checkbox"/> WAM		WAM accounts provide dial-up access and 25 MB of UNIX disk space, including space for a web page. You may also use this account to log in at WAM Labs.
<input type="checkbox"/> Glue		Provides the same services as a WAM account with the exception of dial-up service. Some computer labs require a Glue account.
<input type="checkbox"/> Print Account	SID/UMID Number	Use this account to print in the WAM Labs. You must have a Terrapin Express account to use the print account.

Passwords

WAM/Glue

Passwords are required to be 8-12 characters long with a combination of letters, numbers, or symbols. When your WAM or Glue account is created you choose your password. If you forget your WAM or Glue password you must come to the OIT Help Desk with your photo ID to change the password.

Directory ID

There is no default password for your Directory ID. If you have not set your password or cannot remember it, you can set or change it at the Directory web site, <http://www.directory.umd.edu>. Click **Set or Change Your University Directory Password** to change your password, you must know your Ares or Testudo PIN to use the site. If you do not know your Ares/Testudo PIN, you must come to the OIT Help Desk with a photo ID to change the password.

Print Account

The print account password is automatically generated when the account is created. If you've forgotten the password, you must bring your University ID card to either the OIT Help Desk or the Terrapin Express office located in 1109 South Campus Dining Hall.
